



# VENUS *Hooded Pen*

Your **VENUS HOODED PEN** is a patented precision writing instrument. Take care of it. It will serve you well and give you many years of satisfactory writing.

## The correct way to fill your **VENUS HOODED PEN**

When you fill your **VENUS HOODED PEN** for the first time, open and close the filling lever 5 or 6 times. Repeated flushings moisten the fissures in the ink control unit insuring proper function.

**FILLING:** Immerse pen point so that one half inch of the section is submerged. Open and close filling lever, leaving pen in ink for seven seconds to obtain the maximum supply of ink.

*The **VENUS HOODED PEN** may be filled with either **QUICK-DRYING** or **REGULAR INK**.*

**CAUTION:** The patented Hood unit is designed to control the flow of ink and insure instant writing. After filling, wipe dry and your **VENUS HOODED PEN** is ready to write.

*When your **VENUS HOODED PEN** starts flowing too freely, it is a signal to refill.*

**CLEANING:** Follow the same procedure as when filling—using lukewarm or cold water only. Flush your pen frequently to insure continued trouble-free writing performance.

**IMPORTANT:** The cap of your **VENUS HOODED PEN** should be screwed on firmly when not in use — this will keep the “ink control” fissures moist and free from clogging caused by dry particles of ink. It should be always carried in a vertical position, with cap upright.
